SUMMER CAMP LOYALTY PROGRAM

Lock in 2011 fees for 2012!

The Twin Rivers Council has established a Summer Camp Loyalty Program for resident camp at Camp Boyhaven, Camp Wakpominee, and Rotary Scout Reservation. Through this program, units and Scouts may lock in 2011 camping fees for Summer Camp 2012!

Here's how it works:

1. Register your Unit for summer camp by November 1, 2011

- \$100 non-refundable deposit required to register
- Units that register after November 1, 2011 will pay 2012 fees

2. Register individual Scouts with a \$50 deposit by March 15, 2012

- Deposits are non-refundable, but are transferrable to other Scouts
- Each Scout who registers by March 15, 2012 will receive a camp "Early Bird" patch
- Individual Scouts that do not pay the deposit by March 15 will pay 2012 fees.

3. Pay balance of camper fees by May 1, 2012

- 2011 Regular Fee will be charged
- Failure to pay fee in full by May 1, 2012 will trigger loss of early registration benefit for that Scout. 2012 Late Fee will be charged.
- Camper fees paid will be subject to existing refund procedures, but are transferrable

Additional Information...

- Program is open to in-Council and out of Council units
- Scouts in the program who qualify for camperships will pay based on 2011 Regular Fee
- For late Webelos crossovers and newly registered Scouts in units enrolled in the Loyalty Program, the full fee must be paid by June 1, 2012 to qualify for 2011 rate. After June 1st, the 2012 late fee will apply.
